



## **End | Study Questions**

*Read Revelation 15, and then watch “End” as a HomeTeam. Answer the discussion questions following the film. Then, read and answer the questions below as a group.*

1. The numbers 7 and 10 likely both represent “completeness.” In 15:1 the number 7 speaks of angels and plagues of God’s wrath. This is speaking of Jesus’ return and the final battle removing every last remnant of sin and evil – wiping it from the earth. What are some of things that a world *completely* stricken of sin and evil will no longer deal with?
2. Read vv. 2-3 again. These verses are describing all believers who have been covered in grace, mercy and forgiveness through the blood of Jesus Christ – the sacrificial Lamb. At the end of all things, what does this say their (our) primary task will be?
3. Note the last half of v. 4. On that final day who will recognize God’s presence and power? What does this say about how massive this event will be?
4. Read v. 8 again. The temple was the OT dwelling place of God. Smoke was an ancient symbol for the power and the glory of God. During this event the temple is shown to all and the smoke is thick. In light of this and all of the verses before, do you think God is putting His power or His mercy on display? Could it be both?
