Sunday, Jan 21st, 2007 - "hide"

Read Exodus 2, and then watch "Hide" as a HomeTeam.
Answer the discussion questions following the film. Then, read and answer the questions below as a group.

1. Read vv. 1-3; 10 Feeling threatened by the Hebrew (Jewish) people, Pharaoh ordered all of their new-born males be killed. This is what Moses was spared from by being placed in the Nile. What event, whereby many Hebrews were saved via water, is this foreshadowing in the life of Moses? Hint: See Exodus 14:21-25
2. Read vv. 1-2. Moses was part of the Hebrew lineage called Levites. Levites were the priestly class – those that served in the temples were God's spokesmen to the people. Look ahead to Exodus 19:3-6. How would Moses later take on his true "Levite" role he was once forced to leave behind?
3. Read v. 15. Moses has now been exiled and shunned from both his people of origin and his adopted family. He is forced to flee. This is a motif seen throughout Scripture. Can you think of any other figures who were at some point considered a "nobody" then through God becomes a "somebody?" Hints: Paul, Matthew, Noah What message might this be sending about our *spiritual* existence prior to meeting Him?
4. Read vv. 24-25. God hears the cries of His people and remembers His covenant (promise) to build them into a mighty family of God. He then puts into play a plan to save them. What does this tell us about God's heart towards those He loves? What does this say to us, His people, in the midst of our own 'groanings'?
