*Answer the discussion questions following the film.
Then, read and answer the questions below as a group.*

Acts 11:1-18

1. Read Matthew 15:8-11. Some Jews of Jesus' day had developed a very warped view of God's law. According to Jesus, what is it that truly makes one "clean" or "unclean?"
2. Read Acts 11:7-11 again. Note Peter's emphasis on receiving direction from the Spirit of God Himself to do what he did. Why do you think it was so important for Peter to point this out to his fellow Christians of Jewish descent?
3. Christian baptism is a gift that God gives his people as a sign of their full-fledged entrance into God's family. According to Acts 11:16, what gift accompanies this Christian baptism that separates it from John's symbolic act of repentance?
4. Acts 11:17 indicates that Peter and the others saw Christian baptism as not only bona-fide proof of entrance into God's family, but as something God does – not something we do. Do you agree with that? Why / why not?
